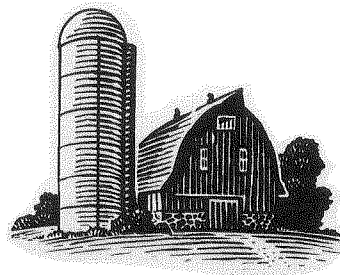
Brat Wagon at Cashwise—April 27th & 28th
